Job Classification: Entry Level Paramedic

Job Duty Summary:

The duties for this position include but are not limited to responding to emergencies, operating equipment, and performing duties to the level of training to suppress fires, effect rescue and perform treatments to sick and injured persons. Working conditions could involve confined spaces above and below grade, working from heights, climbing ladders, in extremes of heat and cold, in contact with known hazardous materials and in areas immediately dangerous to life and health, involving heavy lifting and/or dragging while wearing protective equipment including self-contained breathing apparatus.

- Must pass a background check, psychological exam and NFPA 1582 physical as part of conditional offer a felony conviction may result in candidate disqualification.
- Drug Use Testing Candidates may be subject to a drug test.
